New Phase of Education with an EHC plan – Reminder

The transfer deadline is approaching.

Regulation 18 of the SEN Regs requires that the EHC plan must be reviewed and amended before—

- (a) **31 March** if the transfer is from secondary school to a post-16 institution
- (b) **15 February** in any other case This includes primary to secondary, early years education to school, infant to junior school.

If your child is transferring from any phase of education other than post 16, the local authority should have reviewed, amended and finalised the EHC plan so that is names the placement by **Wednesday 15th February**.

If you disagree with the school named in the final EHC plan you have the right to appeal.
