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### Why take the Ebacc route?

A study by the UCL Institute of Education shows that studying subjects included in the EBacc provides students with **greater opportunities** in further education and increases the likelihood that a student will stay on in **full-time education**. Sutton Trust research reveals that studying the EBacc can help **improve** a young person's **performance** in English and Math's. Languages are an important part of EBacc. Studying a foreign language can be extremely rewarding and exciting.

What's more, we know that **employers value languages**, as they are increasingly important to make sure we can compete in the global market. Because of this, languages are increasingly becoming a **requirement** for many graduate schemes, such as those offered by Lidl.

**To achieve the full English Baccalaureate, a language must be studied at GCSE.** At Brownhills, students study **French** along with English Language and English Literature, Maths, Science, History or Geography.
