I am pleased to invite you to an evening for students, parents and carers on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> April. This will be the final time that we meet for an event together before the start of the external examinations in May and June 2024.

For those of you that do not have younger children in the school, I would like to thank you for your continued support over the last five years and hope that you will join us one last time for this important session to look at final revision strategies for success.

**This evening is completely different from the previous two Prepare to Perform events that you may have attended.** We have taken on board feedback from students, parents and carers, and this evening will focus on the specific content and strategies to revise at home over the next three months.
