Policy



KS3 Home Learning

- Maths and English to set home learning once a week.
- Maths homework will be set on Sparx Maths.
- All other subjects to set home learning once a fortnight.
- All students should read for at least 20 minutes every evening. All KS3 students have access to Sparx Reader. Reading rewards will be given for engagement with Sparx Reader.

KS4 Home Learning

- All subjects to set weekly home learning.
- Maths home learning will be a mixture of Sparx and paper-based homework.
- All subjects will set work that will take at least 45 minutes to complete. As students approach end of unit assessments, assignments and mock examinations, this will increase to reflect the preparation required.
- Core PE, PSHE and RE will not set home learning.
- All students should read for at least 20 minutes every evening. Year 10 students have access to Sparx Reader. Reading rewards will be given for engagement with Sparx Reader.

Student Expectations



- **Completion:** students are expected to complete all home learning to the best of their ability and submit work on time.
- **Responsibility:** students are responsible for managing their time effectively, planning ahead, and seeking clarification from teachers when needed
- **Quality:** home learning should reflect students' best effort and should be completed with an excellent standard of presentation.

Support



- Students should seek support from their subject teachers on an ongoing basis. Teachers will be happy to help and provide additional guidance when required. It is important that students do not leave this until the day before the deadline so that they can get support and still complete their work on time.
- Students who access support from our SEN department can continue to receive support for their home learning by speaking to SEN staff. As normal, parent of students with SEN should contact Miss Plant if they require additional support with home learning.
