Important considerations

- GCSE computer science requires students to be able mathematicians due to the coding element of the course therefore it is recommended you have a minimum target of a grade 5 for Maths.
- · GCSE Music and BTEC Performing Arts will require you to perform solo and group pieces in front of your peers.
- You can only choose one Art course either Graphic Art or Fine Art
- Vocational courses each have an element of controlled assessment. These take place during set time frames in exam conditions. Attendance at these sessions is compulsory. Failure to attend can put you at risk of a grade U.
- · Vocational course are awarded at either a level 1 or a level 2 depending on the standard reached in all assessment elements.

Final option decisions

Whilst every effort will be made to ensure students are allocated their first choices this cannot be guaranteed. Students may be offered one of their other choices where there are insufficient numbers for a course to run.
