



# Brownhills Ormiston Academy

## Student Rewards

### House Points

Students are awarded house points for participating in life at the academy. House points range from 1 to 50 points. The house with the greatest number of points at the end of the year will be named the House Cup Champions.

### Loved Books

Each week students are nominated by their class teacher for having a Loved Book. This means they take pride in their work, their presentation is outstanding and the work they complete is of the highest standard. Students are invited to have hot chocolate with a member of the senior leadership team and discuss their work.

### PROUD

We invite students to share with us what they are PROUD of. This could be work they have completed at school, something they have done at home or an achievement in a club in or out of school. Each visit means 2 house points and a stationary lucky dip. For every 9 visits students are entered into the prize draw to win an iPad at the end of the school year.

### Headteacher's Award

Each week one student per year group is awarded the Headteacher's award. These students are recognised for their outstanding attitude to learning across the academy. Winners of this award win a certificate, 5 house points and an engraved pen.

### Headteacher's Brunch

Once per half term students who have made a sustained and significant impact within the academy are rewarded with a brunch with Mr Doodson. Not only do these students get to share a hot brunch they also receive a certificate and 15 house points.

### Rewards assembly

Each term students are nominated for a subject progress award, personal tutor award and Head of Year award. Students who win these awards are being recognised for their excellence. Winners are rewarded with a certificate in assembly and 10 house points.

### Attendance rewards trip

Each term students who have over 95% attendance and a fantastic behaviour record are eligible for a place on the attendance reward trip. Previously these trips have been to Alton Towers, Drayton Manor and Waterworld. (There is a cost implication for these trips).

### Sports Awards

Each year students who make a significant contribution to sport at Brownhills are invited to the annual sports awards. There are awards for each sports team for coaches' player, most improved player and players player. Students can be awarded half or full colours alongside a range of prestigious individual awards.

### Yearly Awards Ceremony

The yearly awards ceremony is a highlight of the school calendar. At this evening students who have excelled in individual subjects or made a significant contribution to academy life are recognised. These awards are the highest honour at our academy. Each winner receives a certificate and 25 house points.
