The Leading Parent Partnership Award (LPPA) is a nationally recognized award that celebrates schools for outstanding engagement with parents and carers, enhancing student learning and wellbeing.

Overview

The LPPA is designed to help schools develop strong partnerships with all parents and carers, promoting active parental involvement in school life. By increasing parental participation, schools can improve pupil progress, attendance, punctuality, behaviour, and overall outcomes in education. The award is endorsed by the Department for Education and is recognised nationally as a mark of excellence in parental engagement.

The LPPA provides a structured framework for schools to evaluate and enhance their engagement with parents. Key elements of this award include:

- Self-evaluation to identify strengths and areas for improvement
- Inclusive practices ensuring all parents and carers can participate in school activities
- Effective communication strategies to keep parents informed
- Joint parent-child activities and family learning sessions to strengthen home-school links
- Transition support for parents as children move through different stages of education

Achieving the LPPA offers multiple benefits including enhanced parental engagement leading to improved student learning and wellbeing. Stronger home-school relationships, fostering collaboration between staff, pupils and families. Recognition of school excellence, providing evidence for inspections and community credibility. Strategic development of school policies and practices to support ongoing parental involvement.
