Student Rewards

House Points

Students are awarded house points for participating in life at the academy. House points range from 1 to 50 points and are defined into two categories: academic performance and character development. At the end of the year, the cumulative total of house points contributes to awarding the winners of the House Cup.

Loved Books

Each week students are nominated by their class teacher for demonstrating an excellent standard of classwork in their exercise book or booklet. This means they take pride in their work, their presentation is outstanding and the work they complete is of the highest standard. Students are invited to have hot chocolate and a cookie with a member of the senior leadership team where they will discuss their work.

PROUD

Each week, we invite students to share with us what they are PROUD of. This could be work they have completed at school, something they have done at home or an achievement in an enrichment activity. Each visit earns 2 house points, a stationary lucky dip and each half term one student will win a on the spot prize. For every 9 visits students are entered into the prize draw to win an iPad at the end of the school year.

Achievement Directors Award & Head of Year Award

Each week two students per year group are awarded an award from their Achievement Director. These students are recognised for their outstanding attitude to learning, effort in lessons or academic achievement. The Head of Year for each year group will also select two students based on behaviour, attendance or demonstrating excellent character traits. Winners will be recognised with a certificate, 3 house points and will go into a prize draw at the end of each half term to be awarded in the celebration assembly.

Headteacher's Brunch

Once per half term students who have made a sustained and significant impact within the academy are rewarded with a brunch with Mr Doodson. Not only do these students get to share a hot brunch they also receive a certificate and 15 house points.

Celebration assembly

Each term students character development and academic achievement will be celebrated with their Achievement Director's and Head of Year. Students will be nominated by class teachers Personal Tutors and Pastoral staff to receive awards based on academic achievement, attendance and behaviour with winners being awarded a certificate in assembly, 10 house points alongside a range of prize draws.

Attendance rewards trip

Each term students who have over 96% attendance and a fantastic behaviour record are eligible for a place on the (paid for) attendance rewards trip. Previously these trips have been to Alton Towers, Drayton Manor and Waterworld.

Yearly Awards Ceremony/Faculty Awards Ceremony

Each year students who make a significant contribution to Sport or The Arts are invited to attend an award evening to celebrate their achievements with parents and carers. Students hear from an inspirational speaker and receive a range of rewards alongside trophies.

The yearly awards ceremony is a highlight of the school calendar. At this evening students who have excelled in individual subjects or made a significant contribution to academy life are recognised. These awards are the highest honour at our academy. Each winner receives a certificate and 25 house points.
